

Next Steps for the Centre for Youth Voice





Stakeholder Engagement

We will bring together two key groups of stakeholders– a team of Regional Youth Voice Ambassadors and a Youth Voice Practitioner Advisory Group to work closely with us throughout the next two years.



Research and Evidence

We will develop a Youth Voice Observatory, which will act as a data repository for outputs relating to youth voice, which young people and practitioners will be able to view and contribute to.

We'll also develop an annual Youth Voice Survey, to capture regular data from voluntary youth organisations and young people about their youth voice activity.



Intergenerational Governance

We are committed to working towards a model of intergenerational governance at the College whereby young people and adults will jointly govern the College's activities as an intergenerational board of trustees.

We aim to recruit two Under 25 Trustees to support this model in 2024.



Communications

We will offer training and support for our Regional Youth Voice Ambassadors to engage in communications and storytelling work with the College.

We will share learnings from the Centre in a range of visually engaging and accessible formats, taking an intergenerational approach to ensure adult and youth perspectives are considered.

Capacity Building

We will work with our stakeholders to develop intergenerationally approved definitions of 'youth voice' and 'youth participation'.

We will develop a Theory of Change and a monitoring, evaluation, and learning plan to guide the Centre's activities. We will also develop a resource-hub page on our website to house these alongside existing capacity-building resources.
